

Bali Democracy Students Conference (BDSC) "FROM CAMPUS FOR DEMOCRACY"



Nusa Dua, Bali, 7 - 8 December 2017

What is BDSC?

BDSC is a conference among students on the issues of democracy, as part of the 10th Ball Democracy Forum (BDF). The conference is to be held in Nusa Dua, Ball, Indonesia, on 7-8 December 2017, parallel with the 10th BDF.

It is organized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia to mark the 10th of the BDF.

What is the Main Objective of BDSC?

- To transfer and share knowledge about the discourse on democracy at the BDF to young generation
- To get inputs, new ideas, and absorb aspiration and perspectives of the students concerning democracy

Who can participate?

Participants of BDSC are 200 students, consists of:

- Indonesian students from various universities in Indonesia
- International students currently study in Indonesia
- Indonesian students diaspora abroad
- Students from countries around the world

How to participate?

Prepare the following documents:

- Filled-in registration form
- Curriculum Viteae
- Recommendation Letter from the University
- Copy of passport
- Photo (4X6 cm, colour)
- Statement Letter stating willingness to participate in the whole program of BDSC in Bali from 6 to 9 December 2017

The BDSC Committee will bear the cost associated with the participation in the conference, i.e:

- Hotel accommodation from 6 to 9 December 2017 (3 nights)
- Local transport (airport-hotel-venue) from 6 to 9 December 2017
- Meals from 6 to 9 December 2017

Outline of the Conference

The conference, themed "From Campus for Democracy", will conduct deliberation on issues related to democracy from students' perspectives. Participants will convene the Opening Session and Leader's Panel together with the participants of BDF X. Afterwards, participants will participate in BDSC Panel Discussion.

BDSC will discuss, "The Role and Contribution of Students in Democratic Political Processes" in Panel Discussion I, and "Expectation with regard to Deliverables of Democracy: Student and Youth Perspectives" in Panel Discussion II. Panel Discussions will be followed by Plenary Session to formulate the outcome document of BDSC called "Voice of the Youth". Participants of BDSC will rejoin BDF X participants at the Closing Session and a representative of BDSC will be invited to deliver a report at that session
